







# **Product Description**

weber.color dewdrop is a higher polymer modified cementitious water repellant tile grout used for internal and external application. It is suitable for grouting ceramic tiles, vitrified tiles, marbles, granites, mosaics, and natural stone in walls and floors

# **Key Features**

- weber.color dewdrop is recommended for use on tile joints of 1-6 mm width
- · Ensure 24 hours time interval for grouting after tile fixing
- Keep the grouted area free from dust particles for minimum 24 hours
- For best results, use spacers and keep a minimum 2mm joint between tiles
- · If the tiles are highly porous, do a sample test to check for possible staining. To avoid this problem, mask the tiles before grouting

### Consumption

Consumption depends on tile size and joint width. for example for a tile of 20 cm x 20 cm with a 2mm joint width the coverage will approximately 0.2kg/m<sup>2</sup>.

#### **Shelf Life:**

One year from the date of manufacturing for unopened bags, stored in dry condition

# **Directions for Use** Surface preparation

- · Before grouting make sure that the tile joints are clean and free of any loose particles
- · Saturate the joint and prepare it in standard surface dry condition
- This will ensure good adhesion of grout as well as uniform colour after drying



# Application

 Gradually add approximately 2.5 parts of powder to 1 part of clean water (measured by voloume) and mix it to a smooth, workable, stiff paste



- Keep the wet mortar idle for 3-5 minutes before pre wetting
- Do not attempt to extend the pot life by adding more water to the mix
- Mix using a slow sped mixer



- Completely fill the joints of tiles with the weber.color dewdrop diagonally across the tile joint surfaces using a rubber grouting trowel or an appropriate tool
- Wait till weber.color dewdrop has started to set (30 to 45 mins)
- · Remove excess grout using a sponge (45 to 60 mins)
  - After drying about 3 hours clean the tiles using a dry cloth
